How it works!



- ☆ Choose a membership level that matches your families' needs. For your paid membership you will receive a market tote bag.
- ☆ Your membership card allows you to receive your market dollars in \$10 or \$20 increments each week which can be spent with any produce, food or plant vendor. You can spend as much or as little as you would like, saving unused dollars for your next visit.
- ☆ You pay at the beginning of the season and enjoy fresh local food all season long.

A CSA Membership:

- ☆ Benefits farmers
- ☆ Provides a guaranteed market for farmers, helping them to make their farms economically viable.

Builds a strong community:

- ☆ It brings us together at the Farmers' market and deepens community bonds.
- ☆ It makes connections between producers and consumers to help create a system where what we eat locally is what we grow locally.



- ☆ Ensures that our money is going to support a vital local economy.
- ☆ Provides to our community a guaranteed supply of fresh, quality, nutritious food from local farms.

What if I can't afford it?

The Laytonville Farmers' Market will provide free membership to families in need. In return, these families are asked to volunteer in the community garden 15 hours throughout the summer. Volunteers will work with the Garden Coordinator. For those who are not physically able to work in the garden, a \$35 co-pay will be available. You can also donate money towards a membership to help bring quality food to a family in need.
